

IN HIM WE HAVE REDEMPTION THROUGH HIS BLOOD
EPHESIANS 1:7

Redemption means payment of ransom;

JOHN 8:34

Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin.

ROMANS 7:14

For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am of the flesh, sold under sin.

1 CORINTHIANS 7:23

You were bought with a price; do not become bondservants of men.

GALATIANS 3:13

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us--for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"

Redemption means restoration of true freedom;

JOHN 8:36

So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

GALATIANS 5:1

For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

Redemption is done through Christ's blood, which was the purpose of his coming;

ISAIAH 53:12

...he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

MATTHEW 20:28

...the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

1 TIMOTHY 1:15

...Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost.

Forgiveness is total and complete;

PSALM 103:12

[A]s far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

JEREMIAH 31:34

...For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

MICAH 7:19

He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

1 JOHN 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
