2 CORINTHIANS 13:5

2. Granting of a sign of authenticity/guaranteeing the genuine character of the bearer

ROMANS 4:11

[Abraham]received the sign of circumcision as a seal of the righteousness that he had by faith while he was still uncircumcised...

1 CORINTHIANS 9:2

If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you, for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

3. Protecting the bearer from harm

REVELATION 7:3

"Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."

4. A mark of ownership

SONG OF SOLOMON 8:6

Set me as a seal upon your heart, as a seal upon your arm...

2 CORINTHIANS 1:22

...and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.
